Q Data Company was founded in 1999 to provide expert data management and specialized software development for non-profit organizations in the Philadelphia area.

Although we have expanded to include Government agencies and commercial companies, approximately 75% of our work is within the non-profit sector.

For the past eight years we have been designing and developing data management systems for some of the largest non-profit specialty Primary Health Care and Case Management organizations in the Philadelphia area. Some of the organizations that we have worked with include: Philadelphia Fight, Hahnemann University Hospital, The University of Pennsylvania Presbyterian Hospital, The AIDS Law Project of Pennsylvania, ASIAC, The Philadelphia Health Federation and The Mazzoni Center. We have also designed and developed data management systems for The Philadelphia AIDS Consortium, the Temple Beth Hillel Beth El School, The Morning Glory Diner and a customer contact and job and bid tracking software application for M. Cramer and Associates. Recent projects include design and development of the Voice of the Consumer (VOC) data mining and reporting application for The Intel Corporation, and a web based patient tracking and reporting application for Modern Eye Inc.

For three years (2001 - 2003) Q Data Company provided data analysis and reporting for the Electric Production Research Institute (EPRI) of Palo Alto, CA.

In 2002 we were invited to join the Information Services Unit (ISU) Team of the AIDS Activity Coordinating Office of the City of Philadelphia Health Department (AACO). Since then, we have designed and developed/modified several data management systems for the ISU.

In 2004 we were contracted to continue the design and development of ANEMONE, an enterprise software application for The Transitional Work Corporation (TWC is a non-profit training and job placement company). We re-programmed the ANEMONE application to create a robust multi-user application with added functionality and an intuitive user inter face. ANEMONE is currently being used by approximately 100 employees at TWC.

Our current development projects include design and development of three data transfer/migration applications, one for the University of Mississippi Medical Center, one for the State of Mississippi Department of Health, and one for Jordan Hospital of Boston.



We are also developing a Housing placement and Service tracking application for the Client Services Unit of AACO, a custom reporting generator for Hudson County, NJ, and a Contact Mailing List Generator and Donation History tracking system for the AIDS Law Project of Pennsylvania.

Our current service contracts include; installation/configuration/technical support and training for CAREWare (a Federally funded software application for managing client care and reporting on services provided by Ryan White Funded organizations). We are also centralizing all of the data storage and reporting for Ryan White Title I funded service providers in Hudson County, NJ (this includes installation and configuration of CAREWare, design and programming of a custom report generator and providing technical support and training.

Most of our work is accomplished using Microsoft software development applications including: Excel, Visual Basic, Access, SQL Enterprise Manager, SQL Server and Visual Studio .Net. We also incorporate MySQL, HTML and Macro Media Flash when necessary.
